

## Waterloo Field Target Club Results for June 11, 2006

Our June match took place on a typical spring day in Southern Ontario. The temperature stayed in the low sixties with light variable winds. Thirteen shooters turned out for this early season match and I am encouraged about the season to come.

The difficulty of the targets ranged from nine to sixty on the T-scale, so there was a real variety from lane to lane. The wind factor was enough to cause a miss if you did not gauge it properly just at the moment of the shot release; the wind speed did change often enough to make it interesting. Two long lanes, with three targets each, accounted for 77 missed shots out of 156 shots taken. Good day to learn; I know I did.

I enjoyed a day where the crosshairs just sat still and a couple of misreads of the wind led to a couple of missed shots. Second place in the pneumatic class was where the action was, with a three way tie. Magdy left early, after he had finished and was unaware of the tie. Bert and Don were not anxious to shoot off, so by mutual agreement the order was established. It seemed very strange with Dennis Eden away for the first time since I started shooting field target. I'm sure he will be back and ready to go in July.

I had the pleasure of shooting with George who took top honours in the piston class. A tie for second between father and son, James and Josh Jackson, led to a shoot-off on one of those long lanes mentioned above. After several rounds, James took one down that Josh had missed. Dad won this time, but the footsteps must seem real loud now. Both Josh and Zack have been improving at a very rapid rate.

Our next match in Waterloo falls on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, just two weeks before our Canadian Nationals. Be sure to be there in July to get tuned up for the big one taking place during the first weekend in August. Shoot lots and get those rigs fully sorted for some great summer matches.
