

Waterloo Field Target Club Results for June 10, 2007

This was about as close as you can get to a perfect field target day. It was sunny, about 75° and only enough breeze to affect a long shot once in a while. There were nine targets from 12 to 29 on the T-scale, ten targets from 30 to 39 and eleven targets at 40+, which gave the match a good balance. Twelve shooters took part in this match and we hope the numbers continue to grow.

The highlight of the first half of the match had to be that George was shooting clean with his Whiscombe. Many others had only dropped one or two, so some interesting competition was in store for the second half.

The top three in the PCP Division all seemed to have a section of the course that gave them trouble and shot almost clean for the rest of the match. The problem areas were different for each shooter. I dropped one in each of the last two lanes; Don's tough spot was near the middle lanes and Magdy in the last half of the course. I guess that shows the balance of difficulty for the match.

George did end up winning the Piston Division, followed by Tom who shot very well and Zack rounded out the top three.

Hans had some problems with his gun and Ted is still sorting out his B50.

It was great to see Chris out again and he shot very well after a long time away. Salma also recorded a good score at only her second FT match. I hope we will see both of them often.

As usual, there was lots of help pulling up the targets and many thanks to all who helped. Five people were responsible to set up two lanes each, so no one was worked too hard. It sure makes things easier that way.

Thanks to George, the match director, for a great day and nice awards. We will be back in Waterloo for the Canadian National Championships on July 21st and 22nd, where I hope to see lots of friends and make a few new ones.
